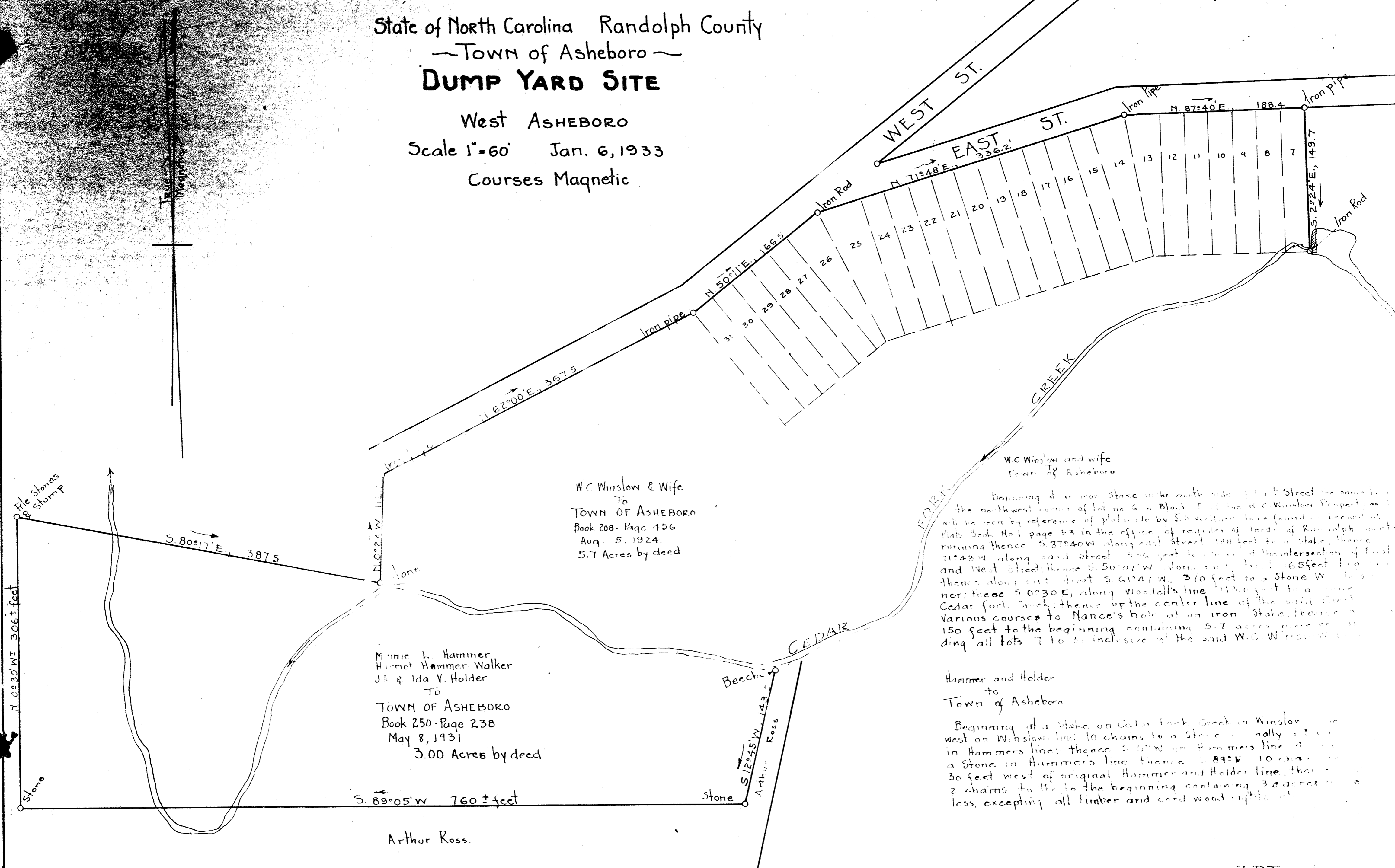

W.C. Winslow and wife

Beginning at an iron stake in the south side of East Street the same being the northwest corner of lot no. 6 in Block 1 of the W.C. Winslow Property as will be seen by reference of plat made by J.S. Winston to be found on record at Plat Book No. 1 page 53 in the office of register of deeds of Randolph County running thence S. 87°40' W. along East Street 188.4 feet to a stake; thence 71°43' W. along said street 336.2 feet to a stake at the intersection of East and West Street; thence S. 50°07' W. along East Street 166.5 feet to a stake; thence along East Street S. 61°47' W. 370 feet to a Stone Well base; thence S. 0°30' E. along Woodell's line 113.0 feet to a stake on Cedar Fork Creek; thence up the center line of the said Creek various courses to Nance's hole at an iron stake; thence N. 150 feet to the beginning containing 5.7 acres more or less including all lots 7 to 31 inclusive of the said W.C. Winslow Property.

Hammer and Holder

Beginning at a stake on Cedar Fork Creek in Winslow's line and west on Winslow's line 10 chains to a Stone Well base; thence S. 5° W. on Hammers line 9 chains to a Stone in Hammers line; thence S. 89° E. 10 chains to a stake 30 feet west of original Hammer and Holder line; thence S. 2° 24' E. 2 chains to the beginning containing 3.0 acres more or less, excepting all timber and sand wood rights.
