REQUIRED INSPECTIONS

Building

- 1) Footing Inspection required prior to any concrete being poured.
- 2) Under slab Inspection, required prior to any concrete being poured (if applicable).
- 3) Foundation Inspections, required after foundation and waterproofing are complete, prior to backfilling.
- 4) Framing Inspection, required after electrical, mechanical and plumbing rough-ins have been completed. A partial framing inspection for the exterior can be performed prior to the installation of siding/brick or other exterior covering.
- 5) Insulation Inspection, required when insulation has been installed.
- 6) Fire Protection Inspection, (if applicable).
- 7) Final Inspection, Required after completion and prior to Certificate of Occupancy being issued.

Electrical

- 1) Under Slab Inspection, as applicable.
- 2) Rough-in Inspection, after all wiring has been installed.
- 3) Final Inspection, after all electrical work has been completed.

Plumbing

- 1) Under Slab Inspection, as applicable.
- 2) Rough-in Inspection, after all plumbing pipe has been installed.
- 3) Final Inspection, after all plumbing work has been completed, fixtures installed.

Heating/Air

- 1) Under Slab Inspection, as applicable.
- 2) Rough-in Inspection.
- 3) Final Inspection, after all mechanical work has been completed.

The inspectors makes these inspections during certain phases of construction and is not on site at all times when construction is in progress. The inspector verifies code compliances and/or code defects visible and subject to discovery during the above listed inspections and spot checks numerous similar items.

Be advised, the owner or contractor must phone inspection requests in directly to the appropriate Inspector prior to midnight the day before the requested inspection.
