

Senior Codes Enforcement Officer

Dept: Building Inspections

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

General Definition of Work

Performs intermediate skilled technical work inspecting residential and commercial buildings for compliance with county ordinances and state building codes, and related work as apparent or assigned. Work is performed under the general direction of the Building Codes Administrator.

Qualification Requirements

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable an individual with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Essential Functions

- Performs field inspections and reinspections of residential facilities for compliance with building, plumbing, mechanical and electrical codes.
- Issues warnings and stop work orders if necessary where construction is not being conducted in compliance with regulations as to methods and/or materials.
- Answers questions from citizens, contractors and builders in regards to building code regulations.
- Prepares reports and keeps records regarding inspections.
- Abides by, enforces and participates in the implementation and ongoing oversight of Randolph County Government safety standards and regulations.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Thorough knowledge of all types of building construction materials and methods, and of stages of construction when possible violations and defects may be most easily observed and corrected; thorough knowledge of state building codes, laws and ordinances; thorough knowledge of standard office equipment, hardware and software; general skill operating standard motor vehicles; general skill using standard tools of the trade; ability to make arithmetic computations using whole numbers, fractions and decimals; ability to compute rates, ratios and percentages; ability to understand and apply governmental accounting practices in the maintenance of financial records; ability to apply algebra, geometry and statistical analysis when preparing reports and records; ability to detect poor workmanship, inferior materials, and hazards of fire and collapse; ability to read and interpret plans, specifications and blueprints accurately and to compare them with construction in process; ability to contact building owners, contractors and the public; ability to be firm in enforcing building codes; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates.

Education and Experience

High school diploma or GED and six or more years experience working in engineering, construction management, construction, or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Physical Requirements

This work requires the regular exertion of up to 10 pounds of force, frequent exertion of up to 25 pounds of force and occasional exertion of up to 50 pounds of force; work regularly requires standing, walking, using hands to finger, handle or feel and lifting, frequently requires speaking or hearing, reaching with hands and arms and pushing or pulling and occasionally requires sitting, climbing or balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching or crawling, tasting or smelling and repetitive motions; work requires close vision, ability to adjust focus, depth perception, color perception and peripheral vision; vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word and conveying detailed or important instructions to others accurately, loudly or quickly; hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels; work requires preparing and analyzing written or computer data, visual

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inspection involving small defects and/or small parts, using of measuring devices, operating machines, operating motor vehicles or equipment and observing general surroundings and activities; work frequently requires exposure to outdoor weather conditions and occasionally requires wet, humid conditions (non-weather), working near moving mechanical parts, working in high, precarious places, exposure to fumes or airborne particles, exposure to toxic or caustic chemicals, exposure to the risk of electrical shock, working with explosives, wearing a self contained breathing apparatus and exposure to bloodborne pathogens and may be required to wear specialized personal protective equipment; work is generally in a moderately noisy location (e.g. business office, light traffic).

Special Requirements

- Standard Level III Inspection Certificate from the North Carolina Code Officials Qualification Board in at least three (3) trades (building, mechanical, plumbing, electrical) and a Standard Level I in the remaining trade at time of hire.
- Valid North Carolina driver's license within 60 days of employment.
