About Us

The Veterans Treatment Court of Randolph County is a 10 panel team that believes in our Veterans and wants to give them all the reasons to succeed in their reacclimation to civilian life. We are a 13-18 month, court-supervised treatment program for Veterans. This program is **VOLUNTARILY** entered into by the Veteran. Once in, the court ordered program will require court appearances, treatment sessions including but not limited to, drug testing, counseling, probation meetings and attendance at community support meetings. At each court appearance, the judge will be given a progress report regarding the participant, at which time the participant will be eligible to participate in the incentive/sanction program. **Successful completion of the program means the charges are reduced or dropped as agreed upon in the court order.**

How It Works

Eligibility:

*Honorable, general (under honorable), general (under other than honorable, bad conduct discharge) and others per Judge and DA discretion.

*At least 1 day of active service after boot camp OR be eligible for disability and/or health care benefits from the VA.

*NO sex crimes, murder or trafficking charges

*other stipulations as deemed appropriate by Judge/DA.
