## Other Food Resources Available:

DoorDash announced on Sunday that it would deliver 1 million free meals and waive all delivery fees for 300,000 grocery orders placed by SNAP recipients through its "Emergency Food Response." The company is partnering with 300 food banks across the nation and will deliver groceries and pantry staples directly to households facing food insecurity.

GoPuff- Following in DoorDash's footsteps, GoPuff pledged to donate up to \$10 million in groceries, and they are offering SNAP users \$50 in free credits for deliveries in November. The credit can be used for staple items like milk, bread, produce, and pantry goods through Gopuff's SNAP-approved delivery service. By offering direct relief when benefits may temporarily pause, Gopuff is ensuring families can maintain access to affordable groceries without disruption. It's a timely lifeline for millions navigating rising costs and federal program delays.
